## NIST 800-171 Basic Needs Assessment and Consultation

This is an initial review of documents, processes, systems, and procedures in place for the protection of Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) in accordance with the guidelines set forth in NIST SP 800-171 (as directed by DFARS 252.204-7012). This initial review includes an on-site needs assessment to determine information security compliance requirements, as well as off-site analysis and report writing.

### Objectives of this service:

- Define and locate the company's CUI
- Determine what standards and measures for CUI are required by current and projected future customers.
- Determine what, if any, standards and measures are in place already (e.g. NIST 800-53, ISO 27002, etc.)
- Determine the applicability of full NIST 800-171 compliance (i.e. Technical Assessment with Written Plan of Action and Milestones, written System Security Plan, and written Incident Response Plan)
- Document current basic information security posture and information security compliance needs

### Upon completion the company will:

- Possess written report assessing information system security compliance requirements based on an initial assessment of current security posture and current/projected customer requirements
- Be able to demonstrate to contract prime/DoD POCs company's initial due diligence (ongoing effort) to achieve information security compliance
