ISO 14001:2015 – Establishing & Implementing

If your company has an existing EMS in place and desires assistance with updating to the new ISO 14001:2015 standard or if your company is starting from scratch: This program is for you. The program outlined below includes the necessary education, training, consulting, and implementation to take your company through the implementation process up to readiness for certification.

The implementation effort is dependent on the size of the company and the number of significant aspects and impacts that are identified. Typically establishing and implementing the environmental management system (EMS) includes:

1. Review of current activities to determine their impact on the environment (air, water, land, natural resources, flora, fauna, humans, and their relationship);
2. Determine which aspects can have a significant impact on the environment;
3. Determine and establish what documented information is needed to meet the requirements of the standard as well as control the processes and their aspects and to continually improve the Company's "foot-print";
4. Once the EMS is established, it is appropriate to educate management and current or potential auditors about the requirements of the EMS;
5. Training of internal auditors should occur when there is sufficient objective evidence (records) of conformance to the EMS's requirements;
6. Off-site phone, text, and email support is made available from the start of the program through to certification;
7. A pre assessment should be completed approximately 4 to 6 weeks before the actual registration assessment or if updating to the new standard, the reassessment date.

The consultant's involvement for a typical Company starting from scratch will require:

1. Documenting the EMS;
2. Overview of their EMS;
3. Internal auditor training;
4. Establishing and implementing the first management review meeting;
5. Off-site phone, text, and email support;
6. A pre assessment.

The consultant's involvement for a typical Company currently registered will require:

1. Adjusting documentation to meet the new requirements;
2. Overview of the new EMS to management and Auditors;
3. Off-site phone, text, and email support.
