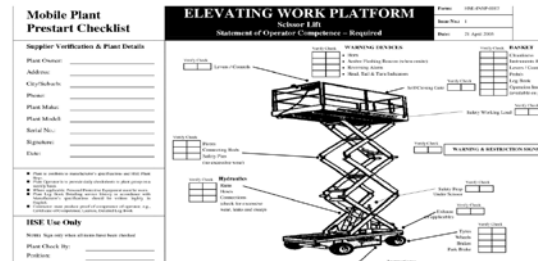
Safety with the Aerial Lift

This four-hour interactive workshop is designed to help participants support a system of continuous improvement within their organization by teaching them a disciplined approach to using Aerial Lifts.

It is intended as an essential guide for employees working on or around aerial lifts. The course provides quick, expert advice on the most critical workplace safety issues caused by misuse of Aerial Lift and Tie off Equipment to OSHA Standard 1910.331.

Upon completion of the workshop an operator will:

- know the dangers of an Aerial Lift in their initial work area:
 - Hazardous locations
 - Drop-offs or holes
 - Bumps, floor obstruction or debris
 - Inadequate surface support to withstand
 - all load forces imposed by the machine
 - Clearance
 - High voltage conductors
 - Overhead obstructions
 - The presence of unauthorized personnel
 - Other possible unsafe conditions
- How to keep themselves safe and how to ensure their follow workers are safe.
- We will teach you how to do a visual inspection of the work area prior to beginning work.
